Conditions of Entry

The regattas will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. Race announcements will be made on VHF including the start area location from 1100 on the 24/25 April weekend. Courses and Sailing Instructions

Racing will take place in the central Solent. Races 1 & 2 will be fixed Solent racing and navigation marks, in accordance with the sailing instructions. Race 3 to 7 will be Windward Leeward Courses. Sailing Instructions will be sent to those who enter before the closing date and will be available from the club on the day. RYA Arbitration will be available for this event.

Scoring, Prizegiving & Suppers

Scoring for the seven race series will be in accordance with the Appendix A with the best 5 races out of 7 to count. If less than five races are sailed on the 24/25 weekend, the number sailed that weekend will count towards the series. Prizegiving will be held as soon as possible after racing on Sunday 25th April at the Royal London Yacht Club, Cowes. Optional club suppers will be available on Saturday 17th and Saturday 24th April if booked ahead on 01983 293153 at £14.50 per person.
